



I trained in the United States, and requalified in Hong Kong. While the pass rate of the re-qualification exam was in the single digits, it was a necessary step for me to establish myself as a fullyfledged IP lawyer in Hong Kong. With perseverance and the support from my supervising partner at the time, I successfully re-qualified locally.

I also enjoy teaching. I had the opportunity to teach IP law at HKU SPACE. This was an enriching experience for me as I often found that no matter how knowledgeable I was on any particular topic, almost inevitably there was something new for me to learn.

While working full-time, I wanted to learn more about the practicality of litigations under the Commonwealth system. So I studied IP litigation at Nottingham Law School. I would travel to Nottingham every quarter for an intensive week of lectures and practicals. The programme lasted for two years. It was extremely valuable in broadening my legal skills allowing me to advise on IP issues holistically and not to artificially compartmentalise legal problems into different disciplines of IP law.
